Club Rules / Information. January 2023

- Membership is open to over 18's only. Members children attend the Club for free.
- Annual Membership runs from 1st October to 30th September regardless of the month of joining. If you do not renew your membership will lapse.
- If you renew after 30th September, you will be deemed a new Member and you will pay a £5.00 joining fee in addition to your membership fee.
- Membership fees are listed on the New Members/Renewal Forms. Applications for new memberships are suspended for the whole of December.
- Members can sign in up to 2 guests for the main bar, which can be varied for events at the committee's discretion.
- Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests at all times. If a Guest is ejected from the Club for breach of these rules, the Member will be held responsible.
- Members should therefore not sign in someone else's guests.
- Members are free to use the Club Garden, but on occasion we may close the garden (i.e., bad weather, private function etc.)
- Use of the car parks is entirely at owner's risk.
- Checks on memberships will be conducted throughout the year. Please do not be offended if your membership is checked, this is to protect genuine Members especially at times of evening entertainment when the Club is busy.
- Please do not allow children to use scooters, bicycles, hover boards, balls, go karts (or similar) within club premises as it contravenes the terms of our insurance policy.
- Children are welcome in the club. Parents are responsible for their children at all times. Please do not leave them unsupervised and they must not run around in the Club.
- The Pool Table is for adults and children over 10. Under 14's must be supervised by an adult and under 10's are not permitted to use the table.
- We have a snooker league playing regularly at the Club and occasionally the table will be reserved for their exclusive use. We will try to publish dates and times in advance where this is possible.
- Committee meetings are held regularly. Details of Committee Members are in the glass cabinet near the front door. You are welcome to use our suggestion box, but please sign your name so that the Committee can address any suggestions, concerns, or complaints.
- We welcome well behaved dogs; however, they must be always kept on a short lead indoors and outside.
- Entertainment and events are advertised through Facebook, our website and text messaging.
- Where possible, members tickets for events are subsidised by the Club.
- Opening hours are subject to change and are listed in the Club / Facebook.
- It is strictly forbidden to bring your own drinks (of any kind) into the Club premises (including the garden).
- Smoking, vaping, and use of e-cigarettes is not permitted in the Club. Please use the smoking area provided.
- Takeaways/hot food must not be consumed in the main club bar. You may use the Willow Room, provided it is not being used for a private event, but all rubbish/etc. must be cleared away.
- Do not use offensive, abusive, or threatening behaviour towards staff or other Members and their guests or Committee Members. This will not be tolerated, and your membership may be suspended/terminated.
- Members and their guests are required to follow any reasonable instruction or request made by either the Committee or bar staff, including leaving the premises.
- CCTV is in use throughout the Club as a condition of our licence and to protect our staff, members, and guests.
- The Club has a zero-tolerance policy regarding suspected drug use/involvement. When suspected, members/their guests may be asked to leave the Club and an investigation undertaken that may lead to suspension/termination of membership.
- The committee are wholly accountable for the management of membership suspension/termination.
